- **Youth Protection**—BSA requirements designed to keep Scouts safe from abuse. Required for all adults who have any contact with the Scouts. Valid for 2 years.
- **Fast Start: Boy Scouting**—General introduction to the role of adults in Scouting and to the purposes and functioning of Boy Scouting. Valid indefinitely.
- **This is Scouting**—Primary leadership orientation about Boy Scouting. Valid indefinitely.
- **Troop Committee Challenge**—Aims & methods of Scouting; role of troop committee. Valid indefinitely.
- **Weather Hazards / Hazardous Weather**—Safety precautions for different types of potentially dangerous weather. Required of at least one adult on any outing. Valid for 2 years.
- **Safe Swim Defense & Safety Afloat**—Key principles for conducting a safe swim activity; and the key principles for conducting a safe canoeing, sailing, or other activity afloat. Valid for 2 years.
- **Trek Safely**—Covers key safety points about trekking. Required for all adults on a troop trek. Valid for 2 years.
- **Leader Specific Training (SM/ASM)**—Covers the adult leadership role in Boy Scouting (3 parts). Valid indefinitely. Provided by local district (www.longspeakbsa.org/CacheLaPoudre/training/boyscout.html).
- **Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills/IOLS**—Covers the outdoor aspects of the Boy Scout program. Valid indefinitely. Provided by local district (www.longspeakbsa.org/CacheLaPoudre/training/boyscout.html).
- **CPR**—Cardio-pulmonary resuscitation. Available through Red Cross or American Heart Association. Valid for 2 years.
- **Standard First Aid**—Basic first aid course. Available through Red Cross. Required for use of Longs Peak Council facilities and on back-country activities. Valid for 3 years.
- **Wilderness First Aid**—Advanced, back-country first aid course. Available through Red Cross. Recommended for back-country treks. Valid for 3 years.
